GENERAL PURPOSE

Perform a variety of duties related to pool-side and water safety duties as needed to assure safe use of pool facilities. Monitor water activities to assure safety and prevent accidents or injury to patrons, and co-workers. Communicate in a respectful, friendly, and professional manner to participants, parents, and members of the public. Ensure the pool deck is clean and clear of debris.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under supervision of the Aquatics Manager and Aquatics Coordinator.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Employee must be able to:

- maintain lifeguard certification.
- attend required training.
- participate in active lifeguarding; constant alertness and awareness of activities is essential.
- contact emergency medical personnel in case of serious injury.
- examine injured persons and administer first aid or cardiopulmonary resuscitation, if necessary, using training and medical supplies and equipment.
- complete required reports accurately and legibly.
- interact positively with co-workers, patrons, swim teams, and spectators.
- assist with conducting water quality checks.
- enforce rules to ensure safety of all patrons, and employees.
- maintain a safe, fun, organized, and clean environment.
- demonstrate positive attitude and behavior.
- must maintain composure, keep emotions in check, avoid aggressive behavior, even in difficult situations.

- perform housekeeping duties on the pool deck, patio, and lifeguard break room.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS and WORK ENVIRONMENT

1. Education and Experience:

A. Sufficient education and training to demonstrate an aptitude or ability to perform above and related duties; specialized training and certification (Red Cross) as a Lifeguard.

B. Six (6) months general experience related to safe swimming, aquatics program participation or related background.

2. Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Some knowledge of the rules and regulations of aquatics facilities; water safety practices; rules and guidelines; first aid, CPR; swimming instruction techniques.

Ability to demonstrate advanced swimming skills.

3. Other Requirements:

- Must be 15 years of age or older.
- Must be Red Cross certified as a lifeguard, or have the ability to achieve certification.
- Must be able to successfully pass a drug screen.
- Must pass background screen.

4. Work Environment:

Incumbents of the position perform in a climate controlled environment. Tasks require a variety of physical activities, generally involving muscular strain, such as swimming, walking, standing, stooping, sitting, reaching. Talking, hearing and seeing details are essential to performing required job functions. Common eye, hand, finger dexterity exist. Mental application utilizes memory for details, verbal instructions, emotional stability and discriminating thinking and some creative problem solving. Work schedule is part-time, up to 29.5 hours per week.
